RE: Public notice for an addition to an Agricultural Security Area – Dyarman vacant farm land, approximately 101 acres, located on Old Mill Road, recorded at Cumberland County Instrument Number 201123042 bearing Cumberland County Tax Parcel Identification Number 14-06-0027-137

This announcement will hereby serve to notify the citizens of Lower Frankford Township, Cumberland County, that the Lower Frankford Township Board of Supervisors has received a proposal for addition to the Agricultural Security Area within Lower Frankford Township, pursuant to the Agricultural Area Security Law, Act 43 of 1981.

The aforementioned proposal is currently on file and available for public inspection at the Lower Frankford Township Municipal Office, 1205 Easy Road, Carlisle (717) 243-0855 between the hours of 8 AM and Noon on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

Any affected Municipality or any landowners who own land which is within, adjacent to, or near the area proposed to be included in the addition to the above named Agricultural Security Area may propose changes to the proposed addition within 15 days of the date this notice is published. Such proposed changes must be submitted to the Lower Frankford Township Office on or before (15 days from notice date).

Upon expiration of the aforementioned 15-day period, the proposed addition to the above named Agricultural Security Area and any proposed changes will be submitted to the Lower Frankford Township Planning Commission and the Cumberland County Planning Commission. Thereafter, a public hearing will be held by the Township Supervisors to consider the Lower Frankford Township Agricultural Security Area addition proposal, any proposed modifications and any recommendations from the Planning Commissions.
